## **JUDGING**

The regional representative will select three competent and impartial judges (non sorors) to judge the essays received, using the **Essay Score Sheet**. She will compute the scores and forward the winning regional essay(s), the judges' score sheets, and names of **all** participants in both middle and high school categories to the **National President Elect** for national judging by **December 30**<sup>th</sup>. The Regional Representative will also send names of regional winner(s) to the National Youth Activities Chairman.

National judging will be in the same manner: three impartial judges, who are not sorors, using the same score sheets.
