



The Eryn L. Fayson Memorial Scholarship was established to honor the memory of Eryn Leslee Fayson, who in June 2022, tragically passed away from brain cancer. Eryn was just 19 years old.

Eryn joined the Future Iota Leaders (FIL) of Epsilon Tau Chapter of Iota Phi Lambda Sorority, Inc. in 2015. As a senior at Booker T. Washington School of Performance and Visual Arts, Eryn was preparing for her college career at Southern Methodist University (SMU). She had a 3.7 GPA and was accepted to SMU in their business program with a concentration in Accounting. She aspired to be a Certified Public Accountant. Eryn submitted her application and won Epsilon Tau's Local Scholarship and the Diego M. Jones Memorial Scholarship in January 2021. She went on to advance to the regional scholarship contest and won the Southwestern Region's Alma I. Mackey Scholarship in March 2021. Eryn had been feeling ill since late January and in early April after many hospital and doctor visits, she was diagnosed with a rare tumor called a High-Grade Glioma. Eryn's first brain surgery was April 9, 2021. She spent her 18th birthday, April 15, in the ICU. The neurosurgeon was able to remove 50% of the tumor. Eryn fought valiantly, although small in stature she powered through rounds of chemotherapy and radiation. She kept the faith and conquered cancer's fear and pain with an undying love for God, her family, and musical artist, J. Cole. Eryn's victory over cancer came before she could claim any of the scholarships she had accumulated to assist in her studies. She leaves a rich legacy of love, intelligence, and sisterhood, that is inspirational to us all.

To honor her memory, Epsilon Tau, and Epsilon Tau Outreach recommend renaming the Epsilon Tau Local Scholarship, the Eryn L. Fayson Memorial Scholarship.

Each year a \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to one female high school student to assist with costs of attending the college of their choice through Epsilon Tau Outreach. To be considered for the Scholarship applicants may be attending any public, private or parochial school within or surrounding Dallas County. Well-rounded high school female seniors who demonstrate a commitment to higher learning, leadership, and a significant commitment to volunteer service in our community are encouraged to apply.

Awarding of the Eryn L. Fayson Memorial Scholarship is contingent on several criteria including acceptance to and enrollment in a four-year college, and a complete application. Scholarship recipients are expected to use their resources wisely and uphold a high standard of conduct.

The Eryn L. Fayson Memorial Scholarship award is an outright grant. Although recipients are under no obligation to make repayment, it is hoped that once graduated and engaged in a productive career they will help honor the memory of Eryn by giving future students similar financial opportunities through Epsilon Tau Outreach.

Recipients of the Eryn L. Fayson Memorial Scholarship award will also be entered as the Epsilon Tau Chapter sponsored applicant into the Alma I. Mackey Southwestern Regional Scholarship (\$3,000, separate application) and the Fredda Witherspoon National Scholarship (\$3,000/8,000) for additional scholarship awards.

FREDDA WITHERSPOON NATIONAL SCHOLASTIC SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

Iota Phi Lambda Sorority awards scholarships for scholastic achievement to female graduating high school seniors wishing to pursue a college degree in business related fields. The National Scholarship is held annually. Judging criteria will include academic performance/achievement, career aspirations, demonstrated leadership, and financial need. Contestants with the supervision of sponsoring chapters must mail their applications to the President Elect postmarked by January 31.

These scholarships are available through local chapters only. A chapter may submit the name of only one contestant.

1. Each chapter may select one candidate whose first occupational choice is in a business-related field.
2. Each candidate must be a female graduating high school senior.
3. The college selected by the winner must be an accredited institution.
4. **Four** \$3000 regional scholarships and **one** \$8000 national scholarship will be awarded annually. Awards are sent to the selected college or university to be applied to the recipient's tuition.
5. The scholarship recipients will be officially notified in May by the National President Elect.
6. The scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment before funds are allocated.
7. A chapter must use Iota's rating sheet in selecting a contestant. Chapters should consider students with excellent scholastic ability as well as those in need of financial assistance.
8. Each chapter must submit the completed **Application Packet** to the National President Elect postmarked by **January 31**.

The Application Packet **must** include the following:

- a. Student Application Form
- b. Student Rating Sheet
- c. Copy of Scholarship Contest Registration Form signed by student. ***Be certain she reads and understands what she is signing.***
- d. A current official/certified academic transcript with SAT or ACT scores
- e. Two letters of recommendations
- f. A 300-500 word autobiographical essay that includes career aspirations, leadership experiences, and significant achievements.
- g. Family income documentation (Copy of the first page of the most recent IRS 1040, please redact SS number)

This Regional Scholarship is held annually. Judging criteria will include academic performance/achievement, career aspirations, demonstrated leadership, and financial need. Contestants with the supervision of sponsoring chapters must mail their applications to the Southwest Region's Scholarship Chair postmarked by February 14.

This scholarship is available through local chapters only. A chapter may submit the name of only one contestant.

1. Each chapter may select one candidate whose first occupational choice is in a business-related field.
2. Each candidate must be a female graduating high school senior.
3. The college selected by the winner must be an accredited institution.
4. **One** regional scholarship for \$1500 per semester or a total of \$3000 will be awarded annually. Awards are sent to the selected college or university to be applied to the recipient's tuition.
5. The scholarship recipient will be officially notified in May by the Southwestern Region Scholarship Chair.
6. The scholarship recipient must provide proof of enrollment before funds are allocated.
7. A chapter must use Iota's rating sheet in selecting a contestant. Chapters should consider students with excellent scholastic ability as well as those in need of financial assistance.
8. Each chapter must submit the completed **Application Packet** to the Southwestern Region Scholarship Chair postmarked by **February 14**.
